Official Rules

- 1. Entry Fee: \$25 per team/angler
- 2. Anglers may enter individually or as a team.
- Teams may have up to three (3) anglers, additional anglers may be added for \$10 per angler 3.
- 4. Only six (6) bream are allowed per angler/team per stringer. Only one (1) non-bream species may be weighed in per angler/team.
- Payback: 100% of total entry fee divided as follows among the following divisions: 5.

Biggest Bream: 50% of total entry fees divided 70/30 between 1st and 2nd places.

Heaviest Stringer: 30% of total entry fees divided 70/30 between 1st and 2nd places.

Largest Non-Bream: 20% of total entry fees divided 70/30 between 1st and 2nd places.

50% + 30% + 20% = 100%

- 6. Optional cash awards will be winner take all of the total entries in each division.
- 7. Non-Bream species may be any freshwater fish species that is not a bream.
- 8. Bream World Champion will be determined as the angler/team with the largest single (1) bream.
- Weigh-in time is from 4 pm to 6 pm, Saturday, June 9, 2012. No fish will be accepted to weigh-in 9. after 6 pm, unless the angler/team is on Red Bay Grocery premises and has checked in with the tournament director. Tournament will end at 6 pm unless noted by the tournament director.
- All participants must follow the rules and regulations of the Florida Fish and Wildlife 10. **Conservation Commission.**
- 11. Fish must be caught by hook and line only. Cast nets, fish traps, and trotlines are prohibited.
- **12.** Fish may be caught in rivers, creeks, mud holes, ditches, streams, canals or private ponds.
- **13.** Time and Place: Tournament starts at safe daylight Saturday, June 9, 2012 and ends at 6 pm, Saturday, June 9, 2012. Fish must be caught during tournament hours. All anglers must be present and checked in with the tournament director at Red Bay Grocery before 6 pm to be eligible.
- 14. Maggots may not be used as live bait.
- **15.** All junior anglers (12 years old or younger) will be recognized.
- **16.** All contestants are subject to a polygraph test!
- Any protest must be made in writing with a \$50 non-refundable deposit, prior to the closing of **17.** scales at 6 pm on Saturday, June 9, 2012.
